## Weaving from right to left



Figure 1 Bring yarn forward between the needles, make sure that the working yarn is above the weaving yarn.



Figure 2 Knit next stitch from chart, leaving yarn in front



Figure 3 Take yarn to back between the needles, making sure that the working yarn is on top of the weaving yarn



Figure 4 Continue working across the chart from right to left, weaving the yarn between the stitches from front to back

## Weaving from left to right



Figure 1 bring yarn forward in a long loop, and take to the back of the work where the chart indicates.



Figure 2 knit the next sts as indicated by chart



Figure 3 Take weaving yarn to back - there is a loop of extra yarn behind the work.



Figure 4 Continue to knit and weave as the chart indicates



Figure 5 WS - Chart row is finished and the extra yarn has formed a loop



Figure 6 Yarn has been tightened and is ready to work the next round
